Directions To The Marina

By Road

- Leave M6 Motorway at Junction 16
- Follows signed to Crewe/Nantwich
- At the first roundabout carry straight on towards Nantwich/Crewe
- The next 3 roundabouts go straight over heading towards Nantwich
- At the next roundabout take the first exit onto Pratchetts Row/A534
- At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Water-Lode/B5341 for 1 mile
- Turn right onto Chester Road/B5341
- Then the Marina is 0.2 miles on your right, enter the first carpark

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FEATURED ROUTES 7 Nights or more

Brewood & Return, 7 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 5.5 Hrs • Total: 35 Hrs • Locks: 56

- Take a leisurely cruise down the scenic Shropshire Union Canal, dotted with pretty towns and villages, to the home of Gingerbread at Market Drayton, and onwards to Brewood in Staffordshire.
- This is a real 'get away from it all' cruise, but still calling at many interesting places to stop and explore on your journey. Average cruising time of just 5 and a half hours means you have plenty of time for sightseeing or taking in an afternoon tea!

Llangollen & Return, 7-10 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 7.5 Hrs • Total: 49 Hrs • Locks: 42

- The Llangollen Canal has some beautiful scenery and breathtaking engineering, and is one of the most popular canals in Britain.
- It combines the gentle countryside of Shropshire and crosses the border into Wales over Chirk Aqueduct.
- It boasts one of the most striking features on the UK canal network- the Pontcysyllte Aqueduct which you will have to travel across before you get to Llangollen.
- Unusually, this canal has a flow of 2mph as it feeds other canals, so the outbound journey will always be slower than on the way back.

Lymm & Return, 7 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 5.5 Hrs • Total: 35 Hrs • Locks: 18

• Perfect for beginners, this route through the Cheshire countryside passes through pretty towns and villages, a couple of aqueducts, a few tunnels, and the opportunity to visit the Anderton Boat Lift Visitor Centre where boats are lifted down to the River Weaver below.

The Four Counties Ring, 10-14 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 4.5 - 6.5 Hrs • Total: 61 Hrs • Locks: 94

A cruise with something for everyone through the counties of Shropshire, Cheshire, Staffordshire and the West Midlands.

- Takes you along the wonderfully rural Staffordshire & Worcestershire Canal to Great Haywood Junction.
- Passing under a distinctive roving bridge, you join the Trent & Mersey Canal heading north towards the Potteries and Peak District.
- Rolling Staffordshire countryside leads you to Stoke-on-Trent, the Wedgwood Visitor Centre and the impressive 2926-yard long Harecastle Tunnel.
- The scenery on the climb up 'Heartbreak Hill' to the summit at Kidsgrove is fantastic.
- Beyond Harecastle the 13 miles to the salt town of Middlewich sees the canal descend 31 locks to the Cheshire Plains.
- The short Middlewich arm links the Trent and Mersey Canal to the Shropshire Union Canal again through more glorious countryside.

Chester & Return, 3-4 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 7 Hrs • Total: 17 • Locks: 22

A scenic cruise through the Cheshire countryside to Chester, with lots to see enroute.

Middlewich & Return, 3 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 5 Hrs • Total: 13 • Locks: 14

Ideal for novices, a relaxed and mostly rural cruise through the Cheshire countryside to the Roman town of Middlewich, famed for its salt production. The first couple of hours are lock-free, meaning you can get used to handling your narrowboat before getting your windlass ready!

Market Drayton & Return, 3 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 7 Hrs • Total: 16 • Locks: 44

Take a cruise down the scenic Shropshire Union Canal, dotted with pretty towns and villages and a couple of lock flights, to the home of Gingerbread at Market Drayton.
