DIRECTIONS

BY ROAD ¹ *If approaching from the South / Midlands via the M6*

- At Junction 21A of M6, exit onto M62 towards Leeds/ Bolton/ Manchester North
- At Junction 12, exit onto M60 towards Leeds/ Bolton/ Ring Road
- At Junction 18, exit onto M66 towards Bury/ Burnley
- Keep right to stay on M66
- Continue onto A56 and keep left to stay on A56
- At Rising Bridge Roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Accrington Bypass/ A56
- At next roundabout, take 2nd exit onto A6068 Clitheroe
- Turn right onto Greenhead Lane
- Continue onto Barden Lane then turn left

BY ROAD ² *If approaching from the North via the M6 motorway*

- On M6, keep left at the fork and continue onto M61, follow signs for Manchester/ Bolton/ Leeds/ Blackburn/ M62/ M65/ M61
- At Junction 9, exit onto M65
- At Junction 8, take the A56/ A6068 exit to Bury/ Manchester/ M66/ Clitheroe
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A6068
- Turn Right onto Greenhead Lane
- Continue onto Barden Lane
- Turn left

FROM AIRPORTS

You will need to fly into Leeds Bradford Airport, which is the closest to the marina. **It is roughly 35 miles away.**

BY RAIL

The closest train station to Reedley Marina is Brierfield Station, which is roughly **3.6 miles away from the marina.**

BINGLEY & RETURN

7 Nights • Cruising Time Per day: 6 Hrs • Locks: 44-60

Burnley to Bingley- through Barrowford Locks, Foulridge Tunnel, Greenberfield / Bank Newton & Gargrave Locks, then option of Bingley 5-Rise / 3-Rise and back.

Boating from Burnley to Bingley is a journey from the nostalgia of lost weaving mills in Burnley, onwards into some of the best open countryside anywhere on England's canal networks, until your journey's end trumpets its thrilling finale in the magnificent canal engineering of Bingley Five-Rise staircase locks.

THE NORTH PENINE RING

21 Nights • Cruising Time Per day: 6 Hrs • Locks: 215

• Also known as the Two Roses Ring, this ring takes in the Leeds & Liverpool canal, Rochdale Canal, Ashton Canal, Calder & Hebble Navigation and Aire & Calder Navigation. The 185 mile route includes numerous aqueducts and swing bridges, 4 tunnels and 215 locks.

• In this challenging adventure, you'll climb and fall on moors and dales, weave through cities with secret histories, tiptoe into nostalgic skylines remembering 'dark satanic mills', and amble along some Britains most tranquil and uncrowded waterways.
