Directions To The Marina

By Road From South

- Leave the M6 at J3 and turn right at the roundabout onto the
- Continue, passing over one roundabout and take the 2nd exit at the next roundabout to remain on the A444.
- Continue, taking the 2nd exit at the next roundabout.
- At the next roundabout take the 1st exit onto College Street.
- At the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Greenmoor Road.
- Turn right onto Croft Road.
- At the roundabout continue straight to Manor Ct Road.
- Turn left onto Midland Road (B4144).
- After crossing over the Coventry canal, take the next right turn, then take the first exit (left) at the roundabout.
- Follow the road to the end, turn right, and then take the next 2 left turns.

By Road From North (A444 & A5)

- Leave the A444 turning onto Old Forge Road.
- Turn right onto Drayton Lane.
- Turn left onto Watling Street (A5).
- Exit the A5 onto Woodford Lane.
- Turn left onto Nuneaton Road (B4111).
- Continue for 1.4 miles.
- Next left after the Windmill Sports & Social Club.
- Take the next 2 left turns.

Airports

The closest airport to the marina is Birmingham International Airport which is a 30 minute drive away (approximately 19 miles).

From London Airports: Make your way via the London Underground, bus or taxi to London Euston train station. From there take a train to Nuneaton which is 2 miles from the marina.

By Train

The nearest rail station is Nuneaton Station where we are just a short distance away (2 miles). Nuneaton rail station can be reached from all the major train stations.

Banbury & Return, 7 Nights

Cruising Time Per day: 8.5Hrs • Total: 54 Hrs • Locks: 50
